You can designate, modify or cancel your donation, or change your banking information at any time, as long as you give the church office written notice. Changes may be reflected the month following receipt of the written change.
- Our PAR Program is administered by the United Church of Canada through an arrangement with the Eastern Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Canada.
